
INSTRUCTIONS FOR READING AND CLEANING 32MM STOCK AND GARDEN METERS

Owner Responsibilities

- 1. Keep area clear of weeds and rubbish;
- 2. Monitor usage to ensure you remain within current water allocation;
- 3. Notify WMI of any meter or outlet malfunctions; and
- 4. Clean filter as required as per instructions on the next page.

Meter Reading



- Example above = 12.345ML
- When the 2nd digit from left changes from 0 to 1 = Used 1 megalitre (ML). One megalitre (1ML) equals one million litres (1,000,000 l).

This Reading = 50,000 litres

OR

0.050ML

Filter Cleaning

- 1. Remove lid from Meter Box.
- 2. Turn off 32mm gate valve located before the filter.
- 3. Release the pressure in the pipe by opening a garden tap and leave the tap open.
- 4. Carefully unscrew the filter bowl by turning anticlockwise.
- 5. Remove filter screen and clean by turning on the 32mm gate valve. Once clean close the gate valve again.
- 6. Replace filter screen and carefully screw filter bowl back on by turning **clockwise**.
- 7. Turn 32mm gate valve back on slowly <u>1 Turn</u> and wait until water is coming out of the garden tap.
 - Turn the garden tap OFF
- 8. Check filter for any leaks. If leaking Repeat steps 2-7.
- 9. If all O.K. open gate valve fully and replace lid on Meter Box.
