Otherwise, the Seller will retain all Water Allocation (including any allocated before any transformation of Water Entitlement Units is registered).

GUIDANCENOTES

The following notes are provided as a guide only and do not have any legal effect. These notes cannot be relied on in substitution for, and do not affect the interpretation of, the Constitution of WMI, the Water Entitlement Agreement, the Water Delivery Agreement, the General Conditions, the WMI Transfer Rules, the WMI Transformation Rules or any other contract or rules that bind WMI and its customers.

- If Water Entitlement Units or water access licences are held, or to be held, jointly by two or more persons, each person must be named as a party and each person must sign this application. The Buyer's details must be identical to the details on their Water Entitlement Agreement.
- The transaction requires the approval of the Board.
- The transaction is subject to the Buyer paying to WMI all outstanding debts and other amounts payable.¹
- It is the Seller's responsibility to obtain consents from all persons holding security interests over the Seller's water access licence.²
- Assuming WaterNSW approves the dealing contemplated by the transaction, WMI will apply to register the dealing with NSW LRS.
- The transaction will take effect upon its entry into the Register by WMI or such other date as WMI may specify.³
