- If Shares are held jointly by two or more persons, each person must be named as a party and each person must sign this application. The Applicant's details must be identical to the details in WMI's register of members.
- 2 Transfer of Shares requires the approval of the Board.¹
- 3 The transaction is subject to the Applicant paying to WMI all outstanding debts and other amounts payable.²
- 4 If either:
 - (1) A member does not, or no longer holds, any Delivery Entitlements; or
 - (2) A member:
 - (a) Is not, or is no longer, a Landholder in respect of a Corresponding Landholding; or
 - (b) Does not hold, or no longer holds, at least one Delivery Entitlement with a Point of Supply associated with the Corresponding Landholding;

then the Board may notify the person concerned that they must make an irrevocable written application for the forfeiture of Shares.³

The transaction will take effect upon its entry into the Registers by WMI or such other date as WMI may specify.⁴
